How to Renew

1. Log in to your myGS and select My Account tab
2. Click on My Household
3. Select Member(s) for Renewal

FOR YOUR HOUSEHOLD

- Click checkbox next to each member (Adult and Girl Scout) renewals
- Reminder to click checkbox for Troop # and volunteer role(s)
- Add renewals

FOR YOUR ENTIRE TROOP

Troop Leaders can renew their troop members all at once!

- Click My Troop and select Troop #
- Click checkbox next to each member (Adult and Girl Scout) renewing
- Reminder to click checkbox for all volunteer role(s)
- Add renewals

4. Confirm member details, choose membership year, choose payment type and submit member detail
5. Review cart
6. Accept the Girl Scout Promise and Law
7. Review final information, add billing and payment information - submit!
