Shelee served as manager of Investor Relations and Strategic Planning at Hawaiian Electric Industries (HEI) and Director of Corporate Finance and Investments. Prior to that, she was a consulting manager at Arthur Andersen and its successor firm, KMH LLP. Shelee holds a Bachelor of Business Administration degree from the University of Hawai'i at Mānoa and is a graduate of the Advanced Management Program of the Wharton School of the University of Pennsylvania.
