

2022 COOKIE PROGRAM BOOTH GUIDE

In the current environment, we have provided additional COVID-19 protocols with our existing booth guidelines for troops to ensure their safety and the safety of everyone—from our Girl Scouts and Volunteers, to customers and business partners and staff. The troop requesting this booth will agree to the following:

Booth Requirements

- Girl Scouts of Hawai'i requires all participants and volunteers to wear face mask covering nose and mouth at all times during product booths.
- Girls and volunteers who are engaging in in-person or booth sales must have a current COVID-19 waiver on file with GSH Council.
- All those at the booth must maintain social distance at all times. GSH will always follow state and local safety guidelines on gathering limits.
- Girl Scouts will always be supervised by adults from the troop and conduct a health screening prior to any booth.
- Girl Scouts will locate table to ensure social distancing.
- The Troop will bring hand sanitizer and have it available at each booth.
- Business may have specific safety requirements (like the number of girls, cleaning protocols or location) that girls and troops must follow. Businesses can list any requirement on the form confirming dates and these instructions will be given to Troops and included in eBudde.
- The troop will encourage touchless payment methods to minimize cash handling.
- The troop will clean and disinfect frequently touched surfaces and are expected to wash/sanitize hands often.
- Girls are required to limit close contact with others and maintain proper distance from customer – social distancing signs are available.
- Girl Scouts and adults will be courteous to all customers and one another, and respectful of businesses space and merchandise and instructions.
- Troops are responsible for bringing their own table, signage, and safety supplies, including hand sanitizer.
- Troops will leave the location as they found it, removing all trash and recycling.

Booth Sanitation and Cleanliness

- Troops are required to locate the table to ensure social distancing and to limit close contact with others and maintain proper distance from customer – social distancing signs are available.
- Each booth table will need to have hand sanitizer accessible to troop and customers.
- Each booth table will need to have sanitation supplies to wipe down any touch points between customers.
- If using a bin method, bins need to be sanitized between each customer.
- Girls and adults should use hand sanitizer between each customer.
- Girls and adults may not attend a booth or in-person sales if they are not comfortable being there or do not agree to these protocols.
