Special Events: Volunteer Appreciation Month

Troop Meeting: Earn the Tree, Sky, or Water Naturalist badges.

Try This: Get outdoors with your troop and explore the nature in your community. Work on the Trail Adventure badges.

For Adults: Talk to caregivers about next year and early bird membership renewal to earn rewards for your troop

Special Events: Destinations & Desserts, Oct. 24; Juliette Gordon Low's Birthday- Founder's Day Cupcake War, October 31

Troop Meeting: Earn the new Democracy badges AND the Girl Scout Way badge.

For Adults: Recruit and register girl and adult members

FEBRUARY

Think Big

Special Events: World Thinking Day, February 22

Troop Meeting: Earn the 2021 World Thinking Day badge

Try This: Celebrate **World Thinking Day** by learning about other countries, GSH February 20

MAY

National Bridging Week, May 1

Special Events: Lei of Aloha, May 29; Memorial Day Lei Draping, May 30
